WELL, COMING INTO WEEK FOUR OF THE FOOTBALL SEASON, THE RED RAIDERS WERE FLYING HIGH AFTER OUTSCORING GANNON AND CLARION 95-37.

SHIPPENSBURG LOOKED TO MAKE IT THREE IN A ROW AGAINST THE C-W POST PIONEERS, WHO ONLY HAD TWENTY-SEVEN POINTS IN THEIR FIRST THREE GAMES.

ALTHOUGH YOU NEVER WOULD HAVE EXPECTED TO SEE WHAT THE PIONEER OFFENSE DID ON SATURDAY AFTERNOON ON LONG ISLAND.

TURNOVERS, AND C-W POST PUTTING UP 551 YARDS OF TOTAL OFFENSE, 366 OF THOSE YARDS ON THE GROUND ALONE, RESULTED IN A 40 TO 22 LOSS FOR SHIPPENSBURG.

ZACH ZULLI, WHO HAD NEAR PERFECT PERFORMANCES AGAINST GANNON AND CLARION, WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR THREE OF THE OFFENSES FOUR TURNOVERS.

ONE OF THE TURNOVERS BEING AN INTERCEPTION, AND TWO FUMBLES, ONE OCCURING ON THE

OPENING DRIVE AND THE OTHER
ON THE FINAL DRIVE OF THE
GAME.

OFFENSIVELY, ALL OF
SHIPPENSBURG'S SCORING WAS
THROUGH THE AIR.

ZULLI HAD 295 YARDS PASSING
AND THREE TOUCHDOWNS IN THE
GAME.

THE FIRST BEING A 44 YARD PASS
TO RECEIVER JAMES
BASKERVILLE AND THE OTHER
TWO BEING A 14 YARDER TO MIKE
FRENETTE AND A 4 YARD PASS TO
TAIMUR HARRIS.

FOLLOWING THE HARRIS
TOUCHDOWN, SHIPPENSBURG
WAS SUCCESSFUL ON A TWO
POINT CONVERSION PASS TO
TIGHT END BRIAN HEITZ, WHICH
GAVE SHIPPENSBURG A 22-19
LEAD EARLY IN THE FOURTH
QUARTER.

AFTER TAKING A 22-19 LEAD, THE
PIONEERS PUT UP 21
UNANSWERED POINTS TO FINISH
THE GAME.

A 73 YARD PUNT RETURN BY C-W
POST'S SEAN PERSCH WAS ONE
OF THE NOTABLE MOMENTS IN

THE FOURTH QUARTER, WHICH
PUT THE GAME OUT OF REACH
FOR THE RED RAIDERS.

SHIPPENSBURG IS NOW TWO AND
TWO OVERALL AND DROP THEIR
FIRST GAME IN CONFERENCE
PLAY.
